3. The pastor emphasized "shouting back" at shame with God's truth. What specific scriptures or truths do you need to "shout" at the lies you've been believing?
4. Paul says in 1 Corinthians 15:58 to be "steadfast, immovable, always abounding." How does shame specifically try to:
 - Move us from our position in Christ?
 - Keep us from serving?
 - Steal our joy and zeal?
